

Thanks to its unique structure, Lunawood Thermowood Composite is one of the most stable composites material on the market. What makes TWPC so durable is the high-quality Thermowood fibre used in its manufacture: the product contains twice as much of this fibre as is found in a piece of solid wood of the same size. The Luna TWPC is three times the density of pine, and it contains more than 65% Thermowood fibre and

about 20% high-quality CIRCO® recycled polypropylene plastic. The product's high Thermowood fibre content and low degree of thermal expansion mean that it will retain its shape and size for decades to come. Luna TWPC is a long-lasting choice for decking, stairs, pools, balconies, jetties and other exterior applications.

Luna TWPC decking products have a brushed surface on one side, while the other surface is grooved – you can choose which side faces upwards when installing. Thanks to their hollow structure, the boards can accommodate cables for lighting and heating solutions.

NATURAL WEATHERING

The effect of UV exposure on Luna Thermowood Composite

Because of the nature of the Thermowood fibre, the silver decking material in particular has a slight brown hue when new, but the colour becomes grey after exposure to sunlight as natural wood. The colours may differ slightly from those shown in the picture: a new product is depicted on the left, with the product six weeks after exposure to sunlight on the right. The initial colour of Luna TWPC decking products fades slightly during the first 6–12 weeks* of exposure to natural UV light. The final colour may vary depending on the amount UV light it is exposed to.

MAINTENANCE AND INSTALLATION

Lunawood Thermowood Composite is ideal wherever exceptional durability and weather resistance is required. Luna TWPC is easy to maintain and doesn't require annual surface treatment. Luna TWPC will give many years of service with minimal maintenance.

- The board surface and the gaps between boards must be brushed regularly and should be washed (with water and a mild detergent) when necessary.
- As the product is not fully water-repellent, any stains, e.g. food and grease smudges, should be removed immediately to prevent them from discolouring the surface.
- As with solid wood, Thermowood Composite is susceptible to scratching, so the feet of any
 furniture placed on it should be equipped with pads. Care should also be taken during construction
 in order to avoid surface abrasion.
- Luna TWPC can be treated with pigmented wood oil to preserve its even colour.
- Avoid hard knocks to keep the decking surface intact.
